

Washing Instructions for Blue Riddell Jerseys

Riddell recommends the following cleaning and storing procedures.

LAUNDRY PREPARATION

1. Launder uniforms immediately after each wearing.
2. Garments that cannot be laundered promptly should be “rinsed out” in cold water (tap water) and hung individually on rust proofs hangers.
3. Perspiration fading will occur if uniforms are left “wet” in a pile or in a travel/laundry bag.

WASHING

1. All garments should be washed in “cold water”. Rinse-water temperature should not vary more than a few degrees from wash-water temperature.
2. Wash with a “mild” detergent (pH under 10.0) for washing all uniforms. (Ex., Ivory, Biz, etc.)
 - Do not use chlorine bleach, or any form of bleaching agent or whitener/brightener. (Extensive fading and /or color bleeding will result.)
 - Do not use fabric softeners or laundry boosters

DRYING

Uniforms should be hung to drip dry
